

USGA RULES SHALL GOVERN ALL PLAY WITH THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES IN EFFECT:

Embedded Ball: "Through the green", a ball which is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground, other than the sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

Water Hazards: HOLE #10: The water hazard to the left of the fairway is deemed to be entirely a lateral water hazard (red) when playing Hole #10. HOLE #11: The water hazard is deemed to be entirely a regular water hazard (yellow) when playing Hole #11. HOLE #18: The water hazard is deemed to be entirely a lateral water hazard (red) when playing Hole #18.

Ball Drop Area: If a ball comes to rest in the water hazard while playing Hole #11, as an additional option under Rule 26, a player may drop a ball in the ball drop area, located adjacent to the green tee.

Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief. Relief from interference may be taken under Rule 24-2. (see Appendix 1-6.)

Out of Bounds: The clubhouse area behind the 9th green, 10th tee and 18th green is out of bounds as defined by the inside edge of concrete curbing or asphalt paved areas.

Stones In Bunkers: Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies. The player may take relief, without penalty following the procedures of this rule.

DEFINITIONS OF BOUNDARIES AND MARGINS

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge, at ground level, of fence posts of both chain link and wood fencing and/or white stakes.

Ground Under Repair: Defined by white lines. **Water Hazards:** Defined by yellow stakes or lines. **Lateral Water Hazards:** Defined by red stakes or lines.
