- 8. When confronted with insoluble marital disagreements between ourselves and/or between ourselves and others, we shall go to an Imam, a Muslim celebrant, a Muslim Council of Jurisprudence/Arbitration/Reconciliation, or a Muslim Marriage Counselor.
- 9. In all legal affairs, including but not limited to, divorce, child custody and/or financial settlement, we shall seek the help, advice and opinion of a legitimate Muslim religious leader mutually agreed upon by both parties.
- 10. In case of irreconcilable differences or any type of abuse, the wife has the right to an Islamic divorce with all the guarantees, implicit and explicit, that the Islamic Jurisprudence tradition grants her. This right will not affect the jurisdiction that a Court of Law (Civil Law and/or Criminal Law) may have in this matter.

11. We understand marriage is a strong Covenant before Almighty Allah. We shall strive always to maintain this Covenant through constant devotion to Him and dedication to our relationship.
