

EMS PRE-HOSPITAL RADIO REPORT TEMPLATE

ALL PROVIDERS

- Report should be 60-90 seconds in a professional manner.
 - 1) Identify Unit and Personnel Calling
 - 2) State Priority and Type
 - a) Priority 1 (Patient's condition is critical and unstable and will require rapid transport)
 - b) Priority 2 (Patient's condition is of less critical nature, can be stabilized by ALS Personnel)
 - c) Priority 3 (Stable patient requiring no or only BLS interventions)
 - d) Priority 4 (Informational calls (death protocol cases, radio checks, etc.))
 - 3) Patient Demographics (Male/Female and Age)
 - 4) Chief Complaint/Reason for Transport
 - 5) Current Vital Signs
 - 6) Providers Immediate Concerns
 - 7) Treatment Provided/ Requested Interventions
 - 8) ETA to Emergency Department
