BY THE NUMBERS:

- > Varsity & Junior Varsity Athletic Participation
 - > 9 12 enrollment 625 students
 - > 251 participated in a Fall sport 40.2%
 - > 118 participated in a Winter sport 18.9%
 - > 210 participating in a Spring sports 33.6%
- Modified Athletic Participation
 - >7th & 8th grade enrollment 286 students
 - > 157 participated in a Fall sport 54.9%
 - > 92 participated in a Winter sport 32.2%
 - > 133 participating in a Spring sports 46.5%

ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION NUMBERS

High School -- 57.9% of high school students participate in at least one varsity/junior varsity sport. (362 out of 625)

Middle School -- 72.4% of middle school students participate in at least one modified sport. (207 out of 286)
