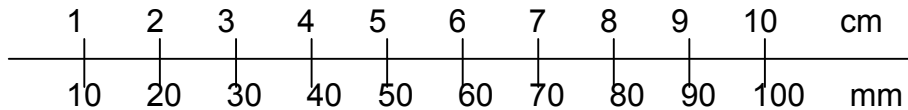


Using a double number line

A double number line is one that has numbers on both sides, eg:

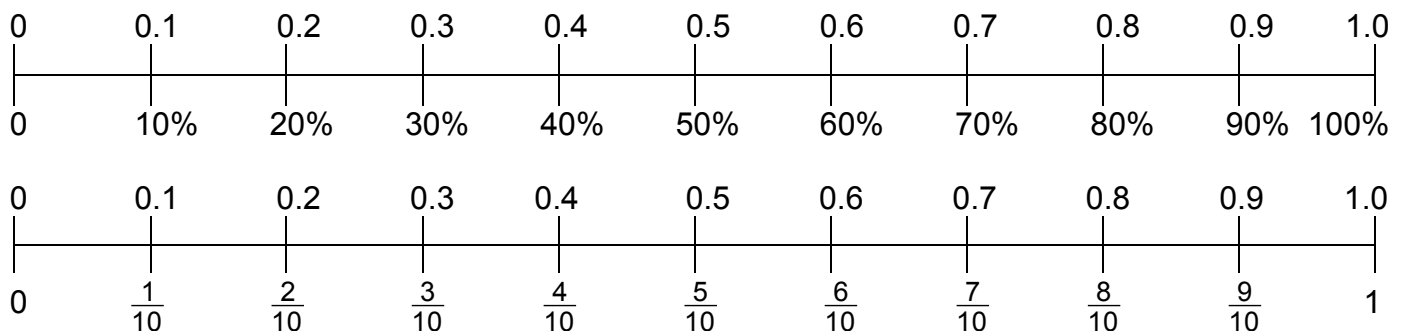


Once you have drawn it, you can use it to do conversions, eg 6 cm = 60 mm

1. Draw a double number line to help you convert between centimetres and metres, (remember 1 metre = 100 cms) and then use it to do the following conversions.

- a. 4 metres = ? cms
- b. 9 metres = ? cms
- c. 200 cms = ? metres
- d. 700 cms = ? metres
- e. 350 cms = ? metres

2. Use these double number lines showing equivalents between fractions, decimals and percentages to complete the conversion table below.
