

## VDH TB Program Reporting Guidance

### TB Disease

- **What to Report**
  - All new presumptive/confirmed TB cases (this includes anyone you are working up for TB; B0s/B1s)
  - TB cases that have transferred from another state or country to your jurisdiction
  - If a case moves within Virginia, the local district initially receiving the report should notify the VDH TB Program
- **When to Report**
  - Within three days of receiving the initial report
- **How to Report**
  - Online via the [VDH TB Central Resource Hub](#)

### TB Infection

- **What to Report**
  - All presumptive/confirmed LTBI cases
- **When to Report**
  - Within three days of diagnosis; treatment information can be updated later, if available
  - For cases identified through a contact investigation you may report these when the contact investigation is completed via the final 502
- **How to Report**
  - Fill out the [Virginia LTBI Reporting Form](#); **OR**
  - Online via the [VDH TB Central Resource Hub](#); **OR**
  - Fax received reports to VDH TB Program at 804-416-5178; **OR**
  - Enter reports directly into VEDSS
  - Final 502s that capture LTBI cases identified in CIs meet the reporting requirement

### Contact Investigation Activities

- **What to Report**
  - The initiation of a CI (Initial 502)
  - The final summary of the CI (Final 502, congregate setting summary, etc.)
- **When to Report**
  - Report initiation of a CI within one month
  - Report the final summary of the CI when all outcome data is known including treatment completion data, lost to f/u, etc.
- **How to Report**
  - Submit Initial and Final 502s online via the [VDH TB Central Resource Hub](#); **OR**
  - Fax Final 502 to the VDH TB Program at 804-416-5178
